

The Wombat is a shallow ground anchoring system that is ideal for marine environments such as beach anchoring and shallow moorings.



With the Wombat you can secure your boat to the beach in seconds or provide a temporary mooring system for deeper anchorage.

- A single Wombat has the ability to provide up to 260kgs of holding force. Enough to hold a 25' boat onshore.
- When you need more holding power just add another Wombat.
- There are no moving parts.
- Wombats can be installed and removed in seconds.
- Wombats are safer as rope runs are shorter and above ground level eliminating rope trip dangers.
- Wombats can be grouped to make up temporary moorings for boats up to 35'. "Move your boat-move your mooring".
- Low cost. No maintenance.
- Saves having to "drop the pick" onshore everytime you leave and return to shore. A quick release clasp provides immediate departure and arrival securing.

The Wombat System

The basic Wombat system consists of the Wombat ground anchor, special 'D' shackle and T-Bar. A double hex socket and power adaptor is available as an accessory for cordless drill applications.



1. Drop boat anchor

Drop the boat anchor at depth and reverse the boat towards the shore to the preferred position.

2. Install the Wombat

Install the Wombat onshore and attach rope (approx 1 to 2m above water line) via a quick release clasp.

3. Swell conditions

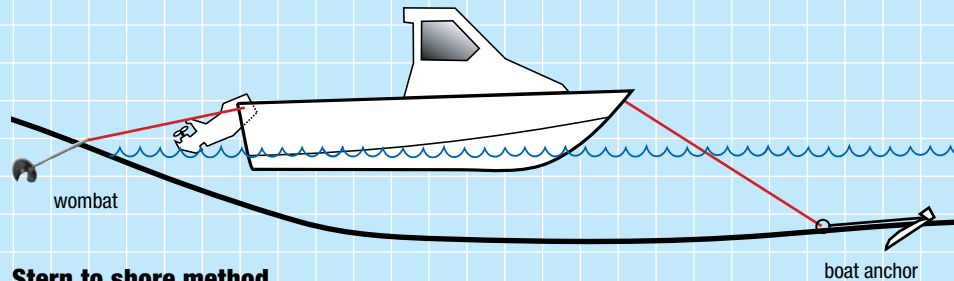
In conditions of swell and strong wind use a "Tommie Springer" rubber snatch cord (or similiar) to limit snatch movement forces.

4. Connect shackle

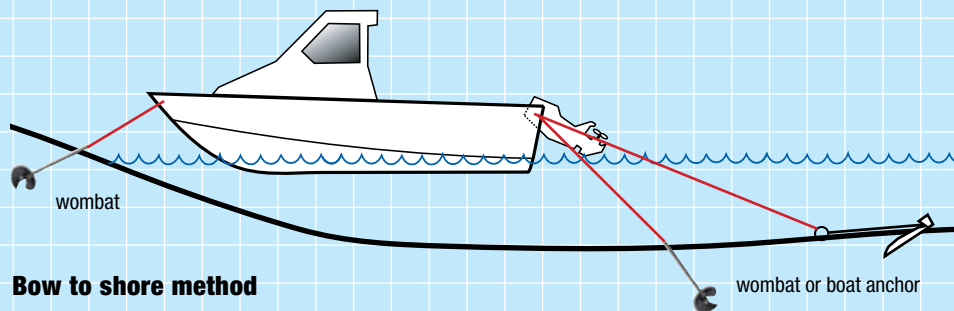
Connect shackle and quick release clipped rope to the Wombat.

5. Departure

Just do the above in reverse.

Bow to shore method

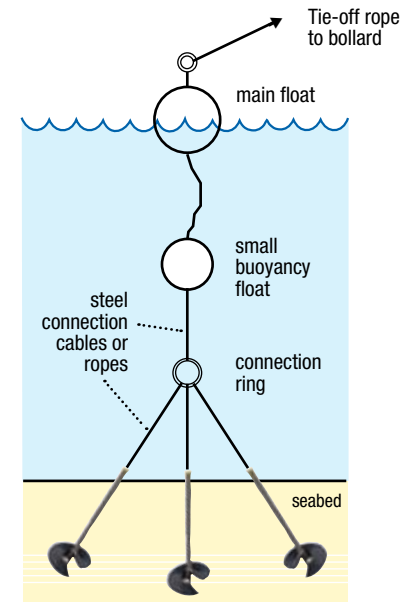
Note:

- a) Boat reversed to shoreline using boat's main anchor to position boat.
- b) There are many anchoring configurations that Wombat can be used for. You should test the holding capacity of the installed Wombats by attempting to move your vessel. The use of products such as "Tommie Springers" (rubber snatch tendons) is highly recommended.

Whack in a Wombat™

A wisdom (group) of Wombats can be used as a strong temporary mooring.
